Tuition

(Does not include uniforms, extracurricular activities, sports, or after school related costs)

Early Childhood (3K, 4K, and Kindergarten)	Lower and Intermediate School (Grades 1 - 5)
\$11,900	\$13,950

- Families that re-enroll by February 28, 2021 receive a \$500 “thank you for re-enrolling” tuition discount.
- For families with multiple students enrolled, a 5% sibling discount is applied to the younger sibling(s) tuition.
- A referral credit of \$250 is awarded when a referred family enrolls and completes the 2021 - 2022 school year.
- Tuition and fees paid by debit/credit card are subject to an additional 2.85% credit card processing fee.
- FACTS charges a \$20 annual fee for 1 or 2 payment plans. Payment plans of 3 or more are charged a \$50 annual fee.
